St Andrews and All saints is a Norman Church with a 15th Century Chancel. The church has many interesting features including a stone altar and 15th century stone scratchings.



Whilst the church is no longer used for regular services, on entering the building you will walk into a strong spiritual presence where you can sense Christian worship and prayers from many centuries.

The church is open during daylight hours. There are permanent displays on the history of the church and the USAAF for whom the church was their parish church during the Second World War.
